Use this form to apply for a new groundwater licence under Part 5 of the *Water Act 1912*.

A groundwater licence allows you to:

- sink a bore, well or excavation which may connect with an aquifer (known as aquifer interference activities)
- take water from an aquifer outside water sharing plan areas,

Who can apply?

Any person can apply for a groundwater licence under the Water Act 1912.

A groundwater licence is deemed to be held by the lawful occupier of the land where the bore, well or excavation is sunk.

Who can use this application form?

Responsibilities for granting and managing water supply work approvals and water use approvals are shared between the Department of Planning and Environment (the department) and WaterNSW.

This application form is for use by the department's customers:

- government agencies, including other NSW government agencies, local councils and the Commonwealth
- state-owned corporations
- water utilities, water supply authorities and licensed network operators under the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006*
- mining activities
- irrigation corporations
- public schools and hospitals
- Aboriginal communities and businesses.
