I am a Northern Rivers resident of 13 years, living on a property at living on the Northern Rivers resident of 13 years, living on a property at living on the November 1 would like to make a short submission regarding the Rous Council's (RCC) Future Water 2060 Project.

The DPIE Far North Coast Water Strategy, which has been on public exhibition, seeks to address reliable water supply into the future. I acknowledge that our water supply is an important issue.

Rous's Future Water 2060 project hinges on the water supply being reliable, based on the construction of the contentious Dunoon Dam. Rous Future Water 2060 fails to mention system resilience as important, and seriously examined only groundwater, and the Dunoon Dam option.

There is widespread concern in the Northern Rivers regarding the destructiveness of a Dam. There is also concern over the failure of RCC to plan for water resilience using modern technologies. 91% of 1290 written and online submissions to RCC opposed the dam option.

I would like to add my voice to those objecting to the Dunoon Dam option. The Dam will create more problems (financial, environmental and social) than it will solve.
