#### 1 Name of Order

This Order is the Available Water Determination Order for Namoi and Peel Unregulated Rivers Water Sources 2025

#### 2 Commencement

This Order commences on the 18th day of March 2025.

#### 3 Available water determination

This Order determines the availability of water in relation to the water sources specified in Schedule 1, for the categories and subcategories of access licence specified in Schedule 2, on the terms specified in Schedule 2.

#### Schedule 1 Water Sources

This Order applies to the following water sources as identified in clause 4 of the Water Sharing Plan for the Namoi and Peel Unregulated Rivers Water Sources 2012:

- 1. Quirindi creek water source
- 2. Eulah creek water source
- 3. Pian creek water source
- 4. Mooki river water source
- 5. Coxs creek water source
- 6. Werris creek water source
- 7. Bluevale water source
- 8. Lake Goran water source
- 9. Bundock creek water source
- 10. Rangira creek water source

#### Schedule 2 Access licences and terms

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to the adjacent category/subcategory of access licence specified in Column 1.
