Who can apply?

Only an approval holder can apply for the amendment of their water supply work approval and/or water use approval.

Who can use this application form?

Responsibilities for granting and managing water supply work approvals and water use approvals are shared between the NSW Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (the department) and WaterNSW.

This application form is for use by the department's customers:

- government agencies, including other NSW government agencies, local councils, and the Commonwealth
- state-owned corporations
- water utilities, water supply authorities and licensed network operators under the Water Industry Competition Act 2006
- mining activities



- irrigation corporations
- public schools and hospitals

- acid sulphate soils assessment and management report (if acid sulphate soils present at site).



Additional requirements for dewatering applications

- any environmental impact statements, including predicted outcomes
- hydrogeology report, including any outcomes
- any areas covered by a specific management plan, including Dewatering Management Plan
- for low-risk activities, a supporting statement outlining nature of work.

Offences and penalties

It is an offence, under section 344 of the *Water Management Act 2000*, to make a statement that you know to be false or misleading in, or in connection with, this application. A corporation found guilty of an offence against section 344 is liable to a penalty not exceeding \$2.002 million. An individual found guilty of an offence against section 344 is liable to a penalty not exceeding \$500,500.

An access licence or approval may be suspended or cancelled under the *Water Management Act* 2000 in certain circumstances. These include if the holder of the license or approval is convicted of an offence under that Act.
